



## COMPETITION RULES FOR 2024

Every year, two teachers of French (one in primary and one in secondary school) will be selected for their significant and committed contribution to French language education in their school and community.

### > IMPORTANT DATES

- Teachers must submit their application form by **Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> November 2024**
- The award ceremony will be held on **Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2024**

### > WHO CAN APPLY?

The award is designed for **French language primary and secondary teachers** teaching in the **UK school system (England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland)**.

Application may be submitted by teachers themselves or by someone in their stead.

### > HOW TO APPLY?

To apply, teachers must complete the application form, have it signed and stamped by their head teacher, and submit it to [projects-education@institut-francais.org.uk](mailto:projects-education@institut-francais.org.uk) by **Thursday 21st November 2024**.

### > THE JURY

The jury is made of national members experienced French language practitioners and members of the Institut français du Royaume-Uni who will pay attention to the following criteria:

- the participants' record of successful French teaching at a school, including innovative language teaching and cross curricular activities;
- the participants' successful introduction of French teaching at a school (e.g., first foreign language or new language);
- the participants' initiatives to promote good progress and love of learning French.

### > AWARD CEREMONY

The award ceremony will be held on **Saturday 7th December 2024** at the **Institut français du Royaume-Uni in London**.

Winners will receive special prizes such as gift vouchers and more to enjoy outside the classroom.
